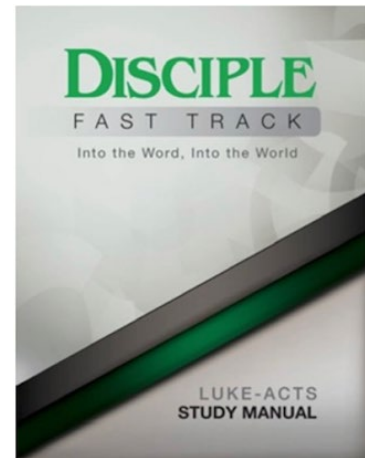
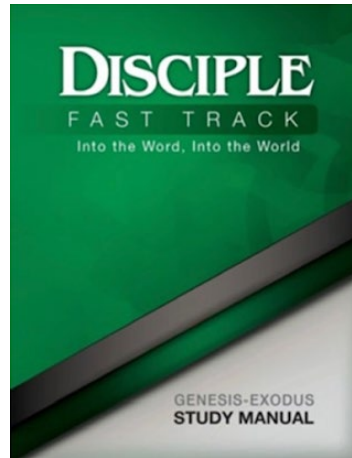

Starting: Wednesday, August 31

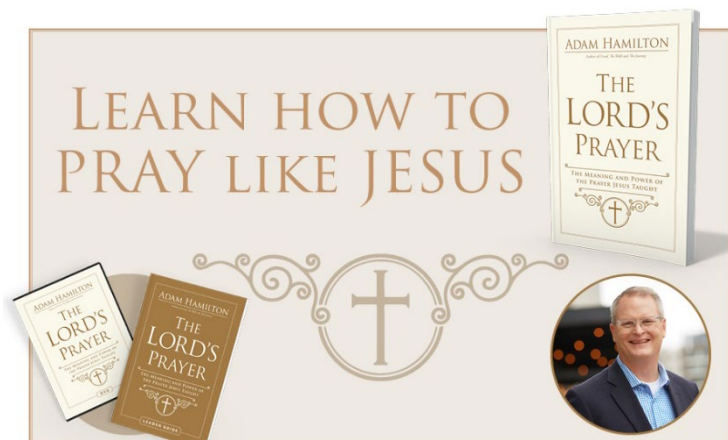
